CALL FOR PILOT PROJECTS

- Strategic Funding Decisions to Work Your Plans!
 - Funding is for pilot projects to help achieve strategies identified in coordinated plans
 - TxDOT anticipates having \$700,000 - \$800,000 to award statewide for FY 2018; number of awards will be limited
 - Eligibility not exclusive to lead agencies

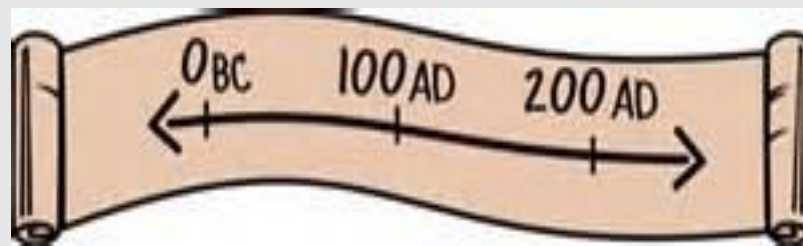




CALL FOR PILOT PROJECTS

Timeline

- Late Nov. 2016: Publish RFP
 - Dec. 2016: Pre-Application webinars
 - March 2017: Proposals due
 - Sept. 2017: Contracts executed

CALL FOR PILOT PROJECTS

What is a pilot project?

- Small-scale, preliminary study
 - To evaluate effectiveness, efficiencies, feasibility, time, cost or other aspects or effects of a specific attempt to improve services, products, methods or systems
 - To determine if & how a similar project might be refined & replicated elsewhere or on a larger scale

CALL FOR PILOT PROJECTS

- Pilot projects will culminate with development of a final report describing methodology, observations, recommendations
 - Projects should be ready to *begin* Sept. 2017
 - Applicants should present thoroughly thought-through pilot project proposals addressing what, where, when, how and who
